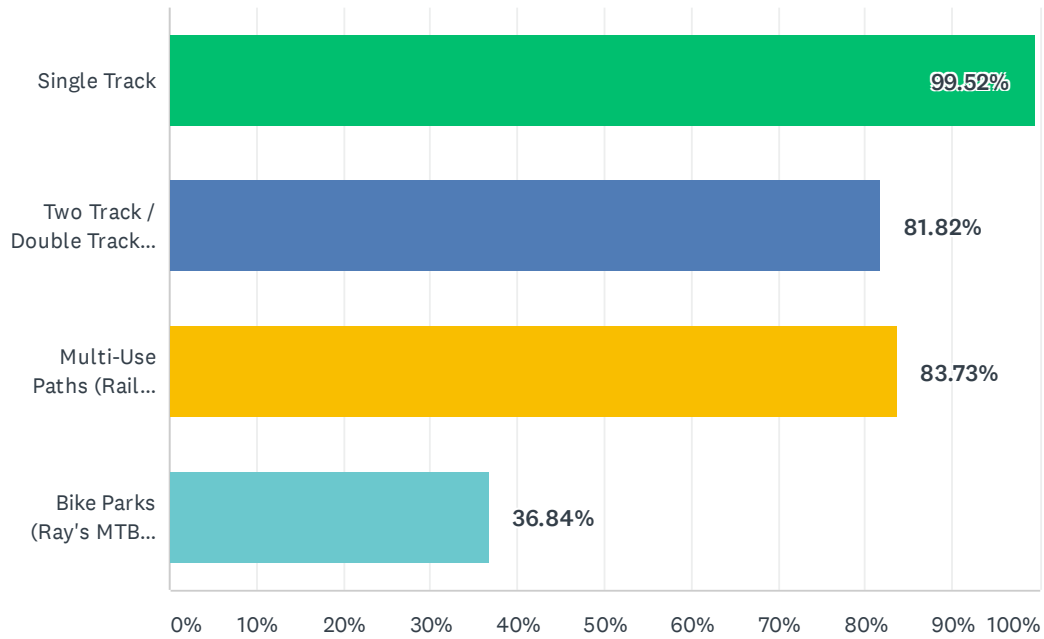

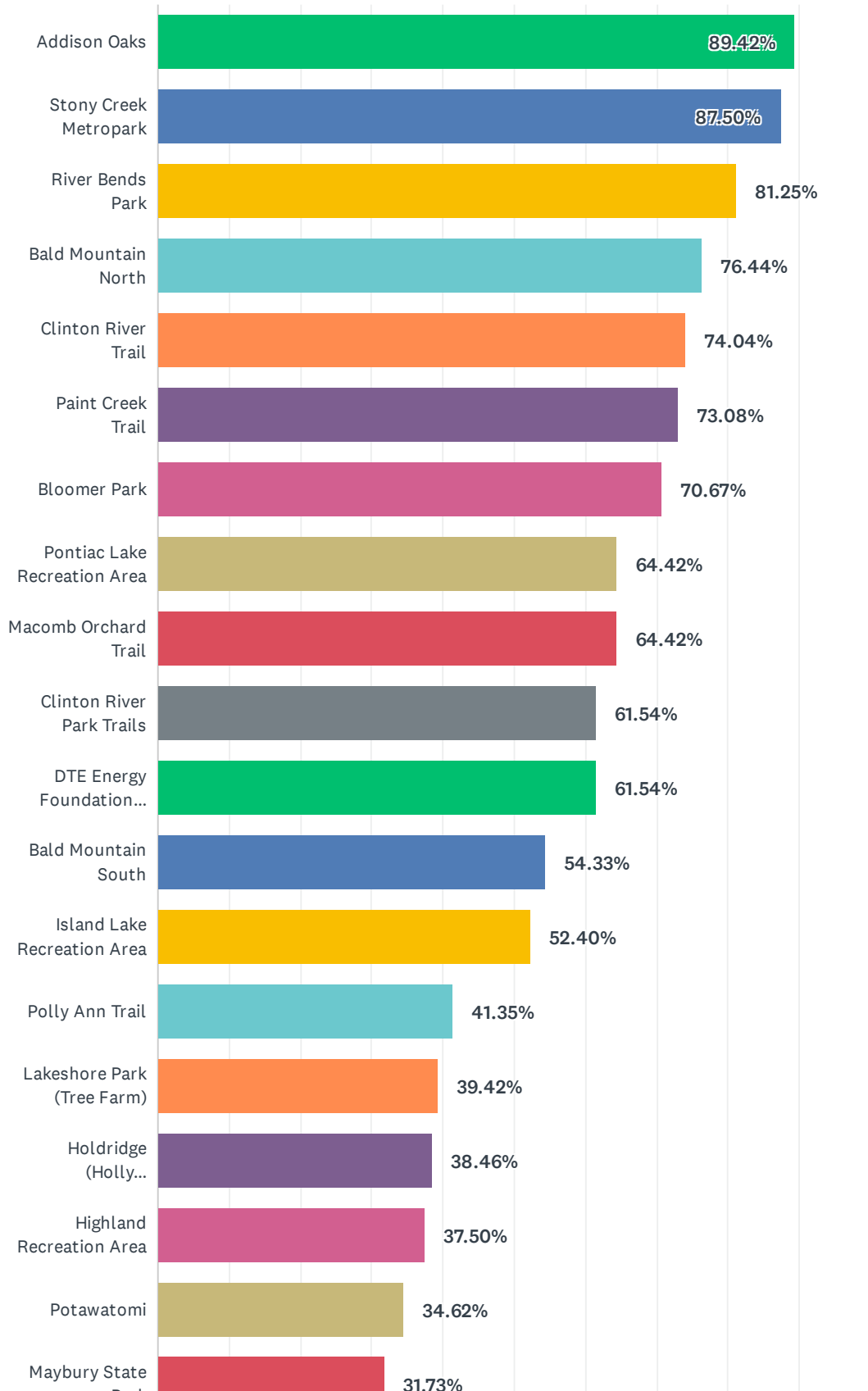

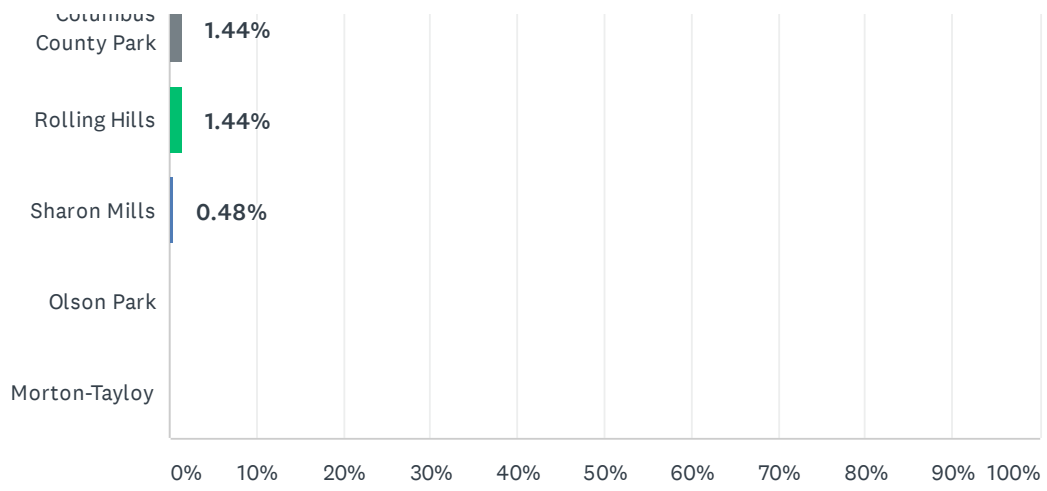

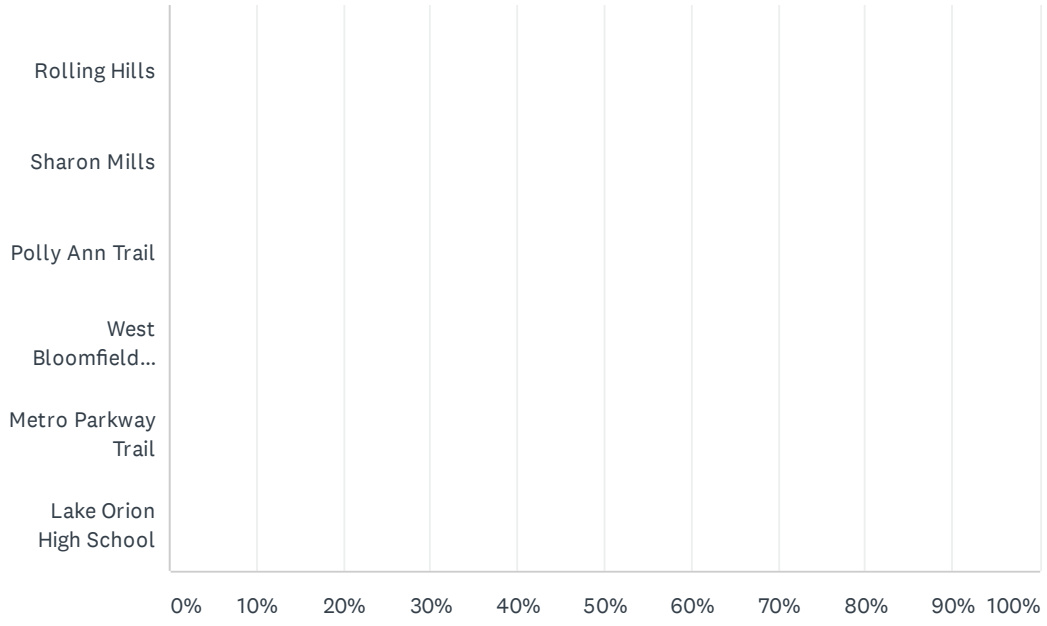

Q5 Which Southeast Michigan trail do you use the most?

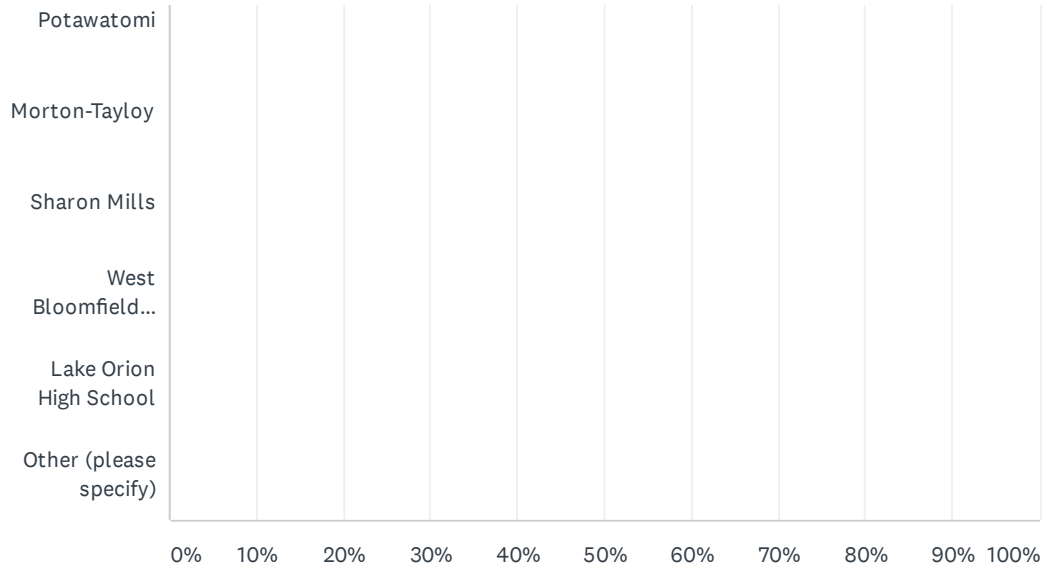

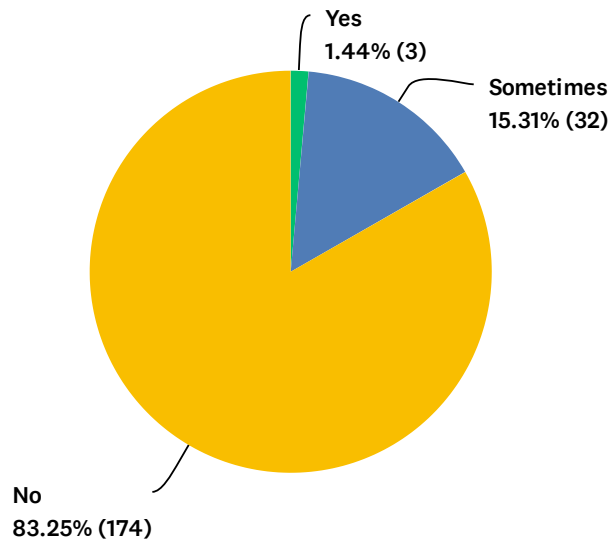

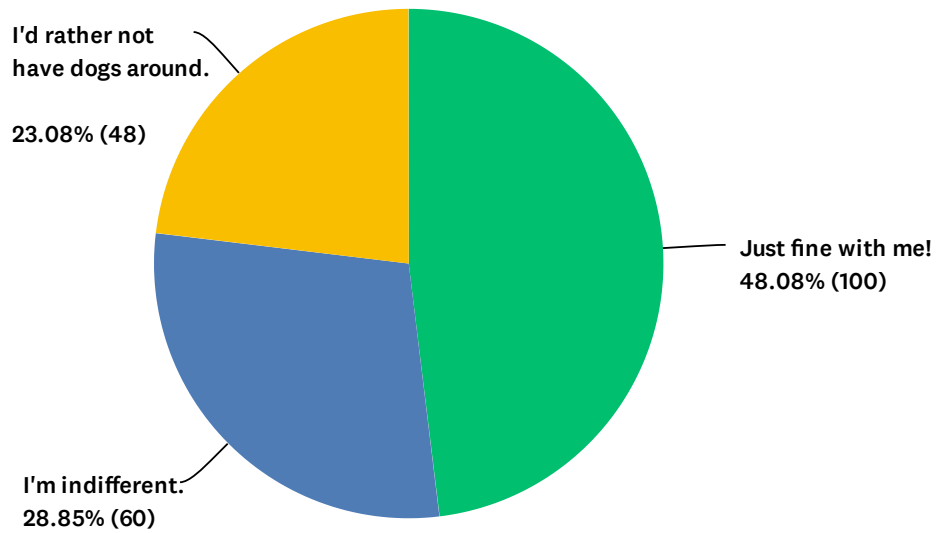

Q14 How do you feel about other trail users having dogs?

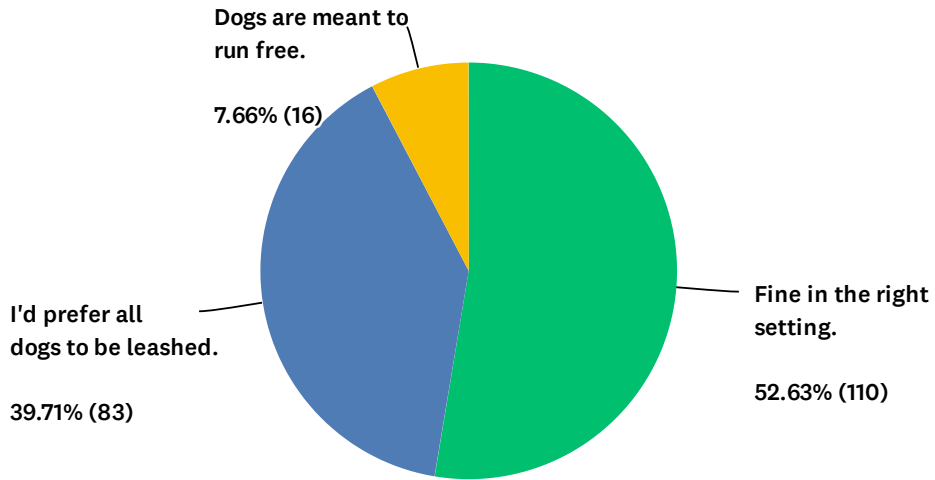

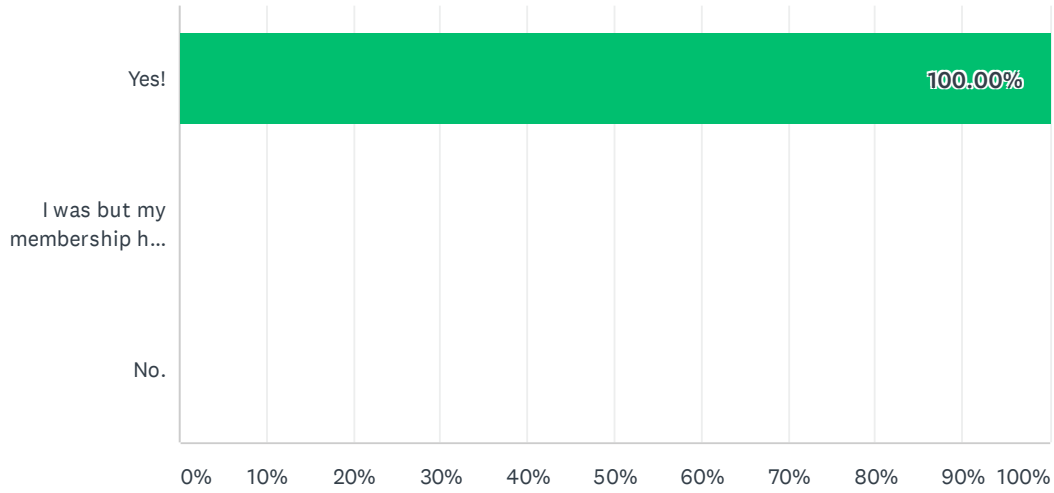

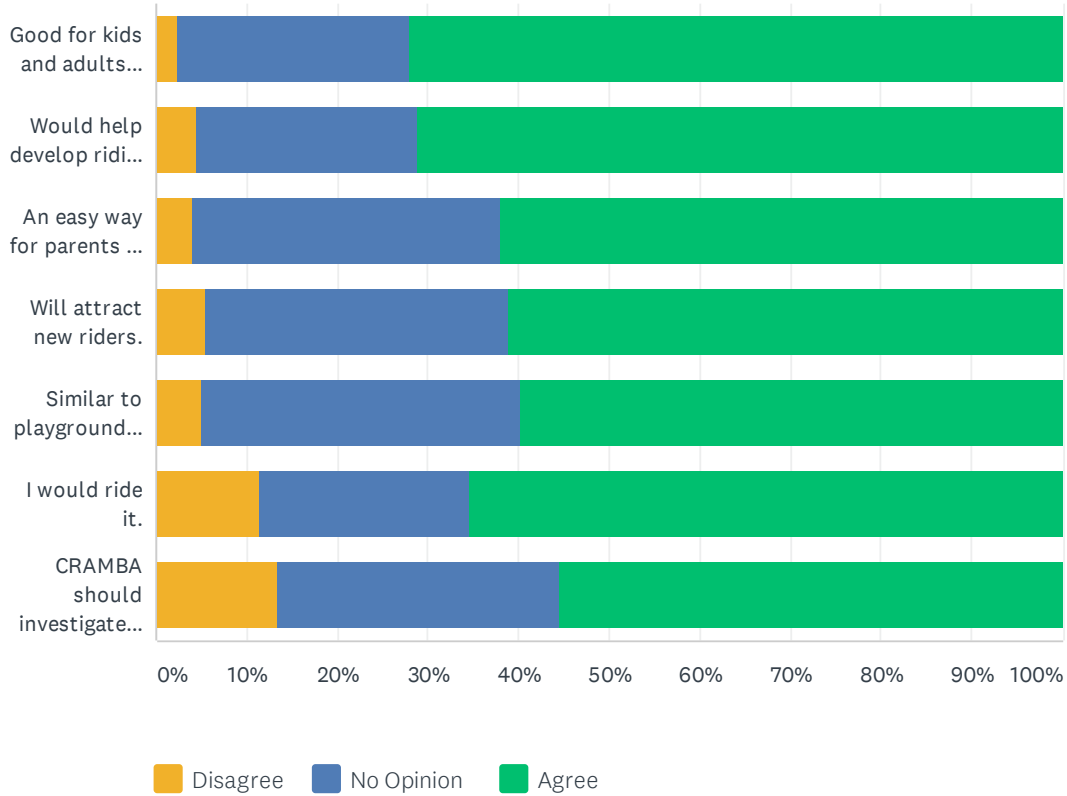

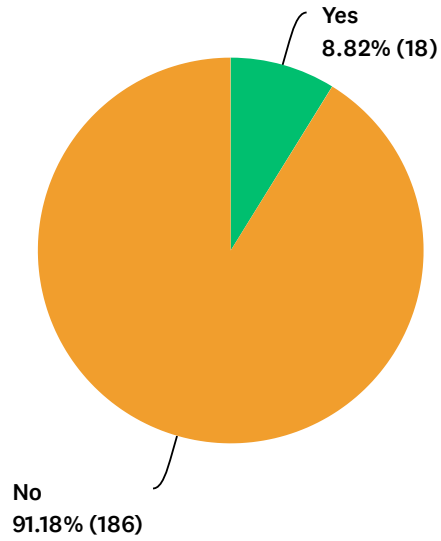

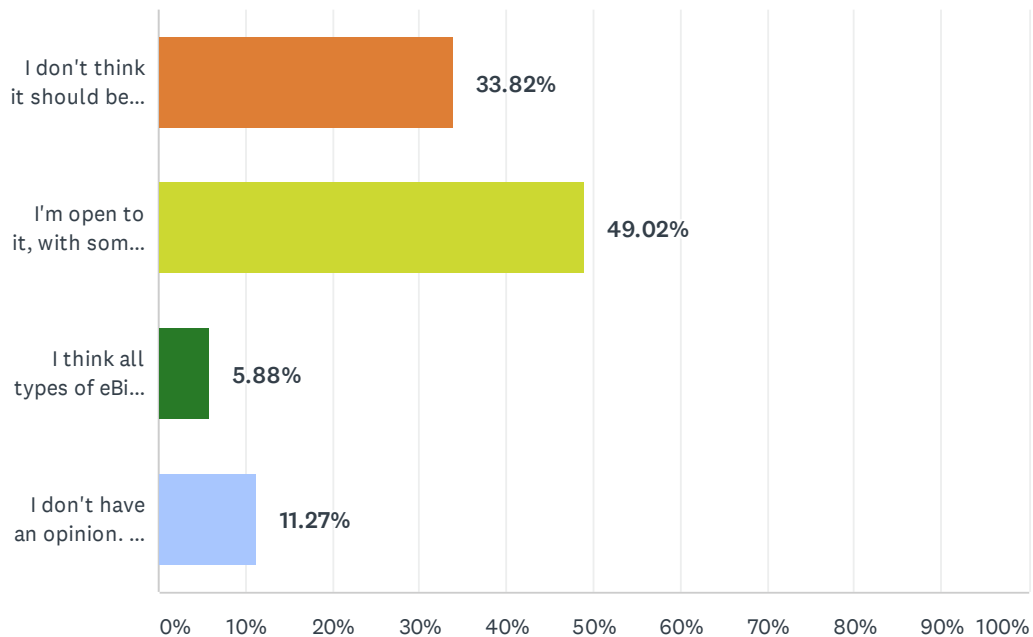

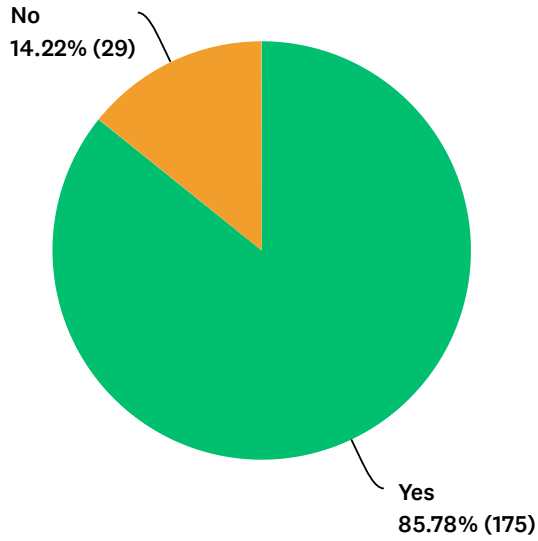

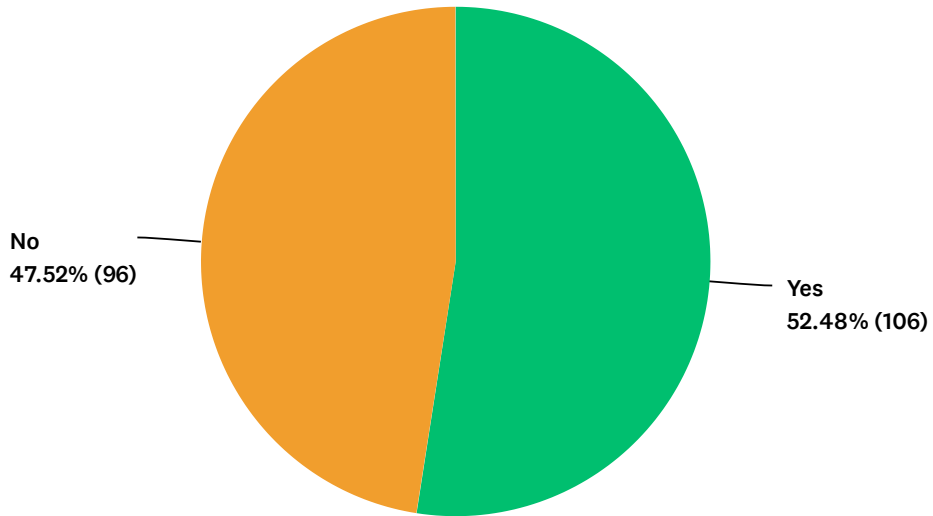

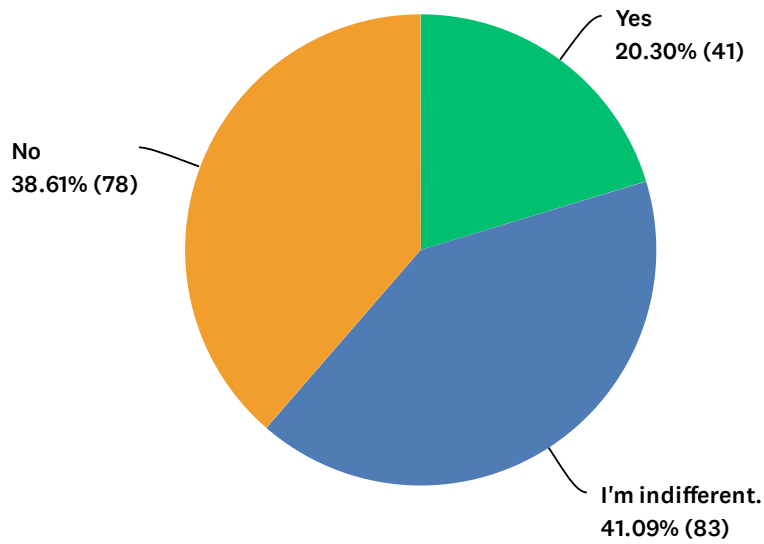

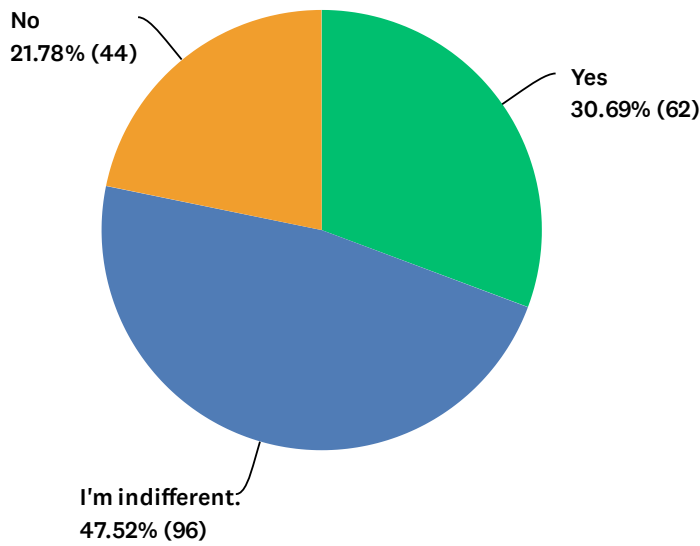

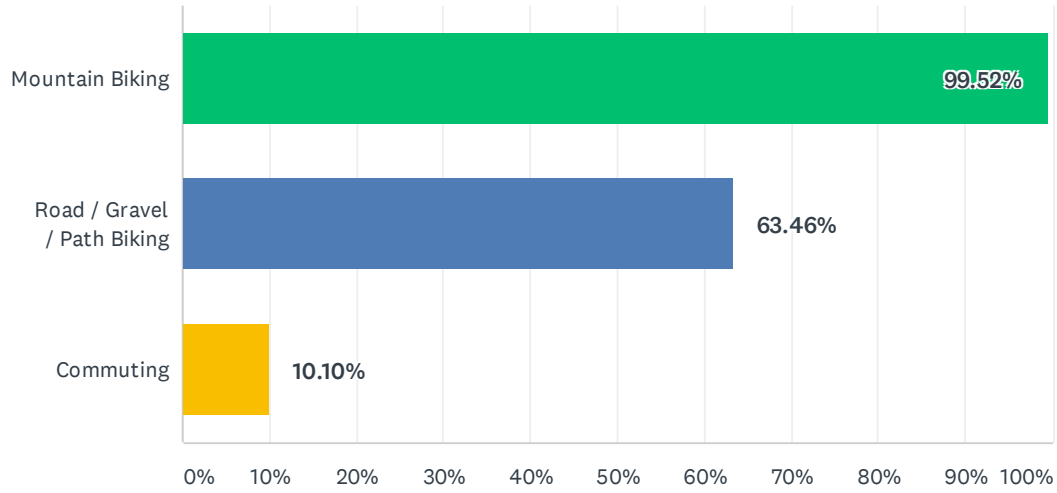

Q29 What kind of biking do you do on trails?

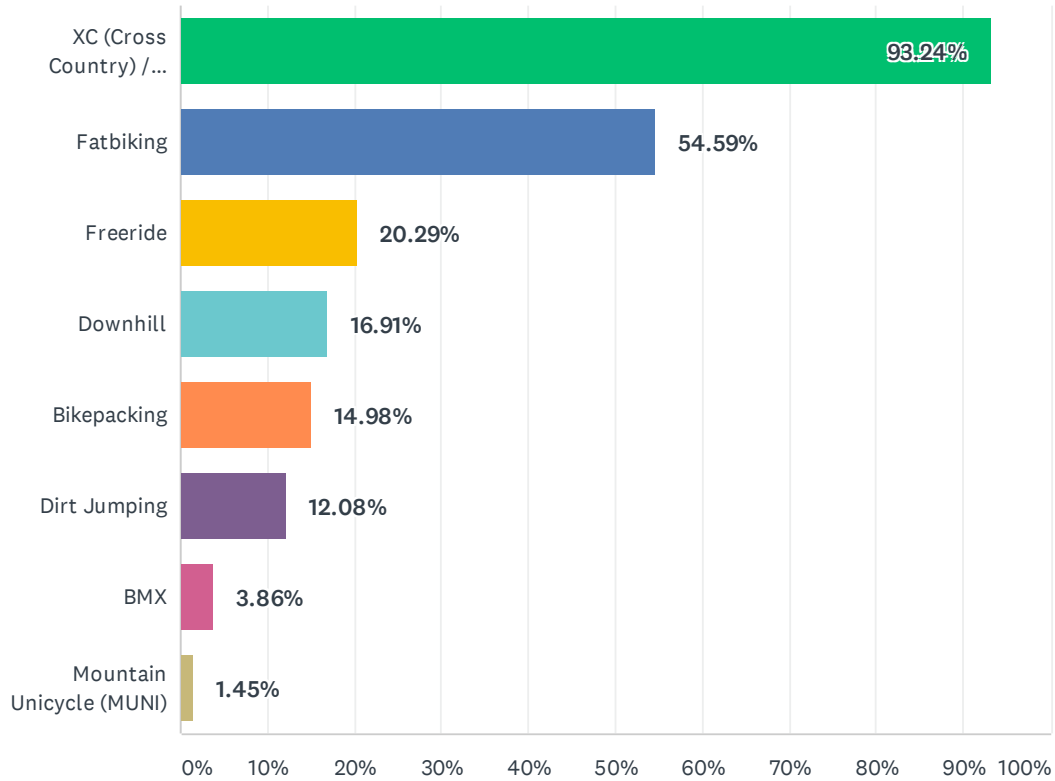

Q30 What types of mountain biking do you do?

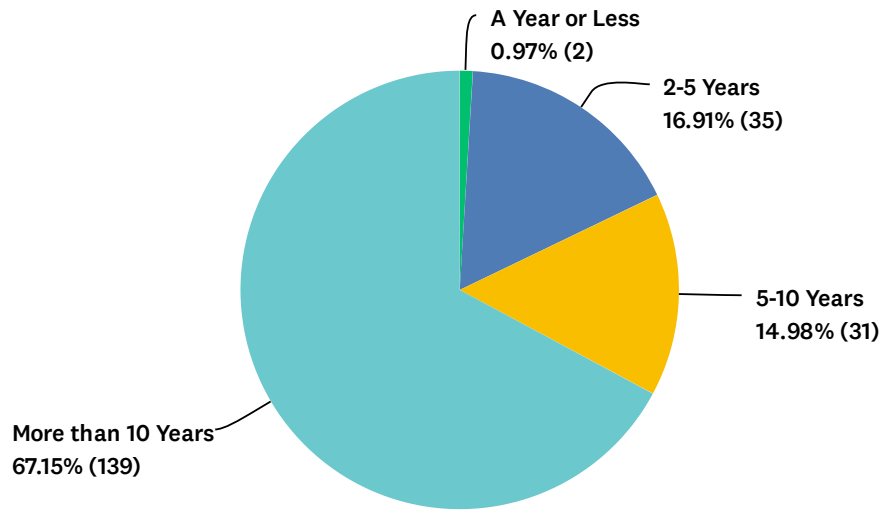

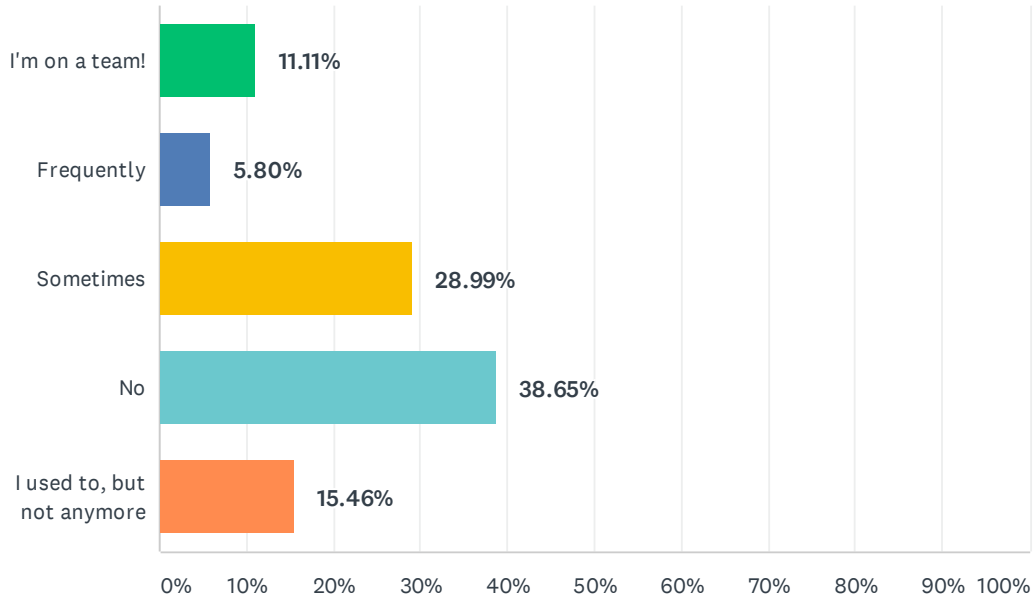

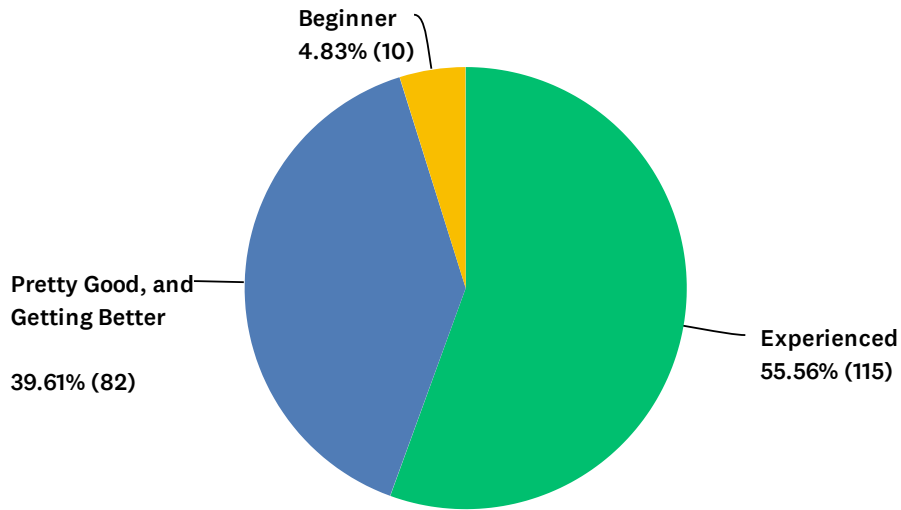

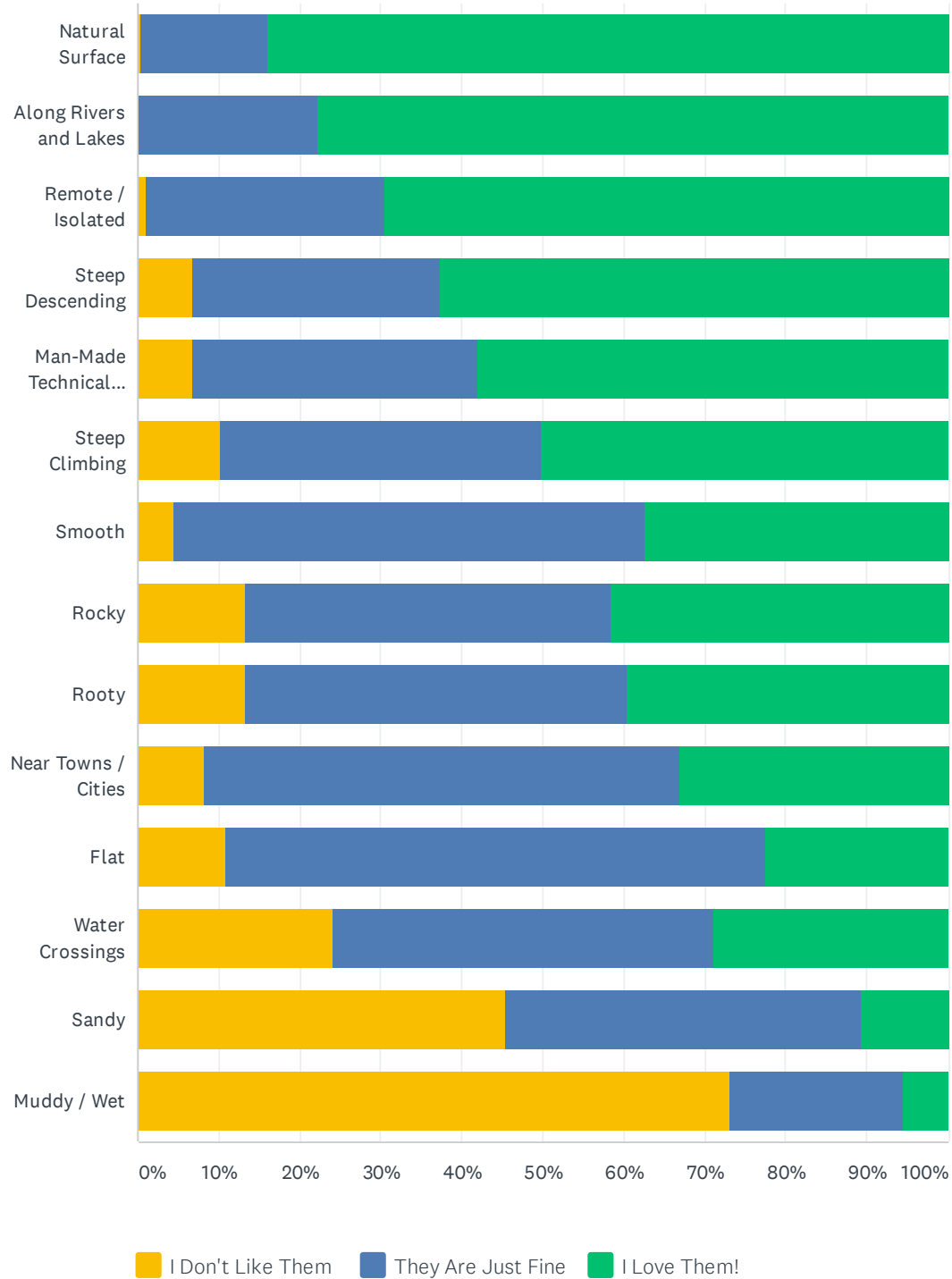

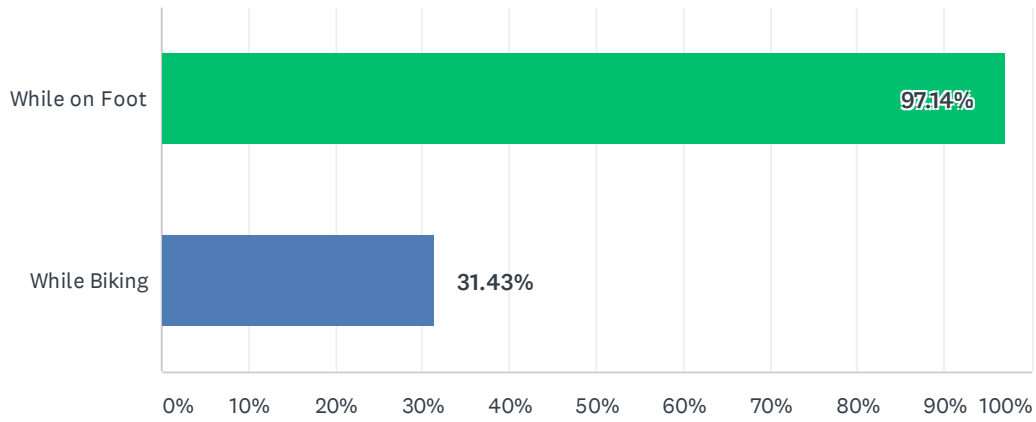

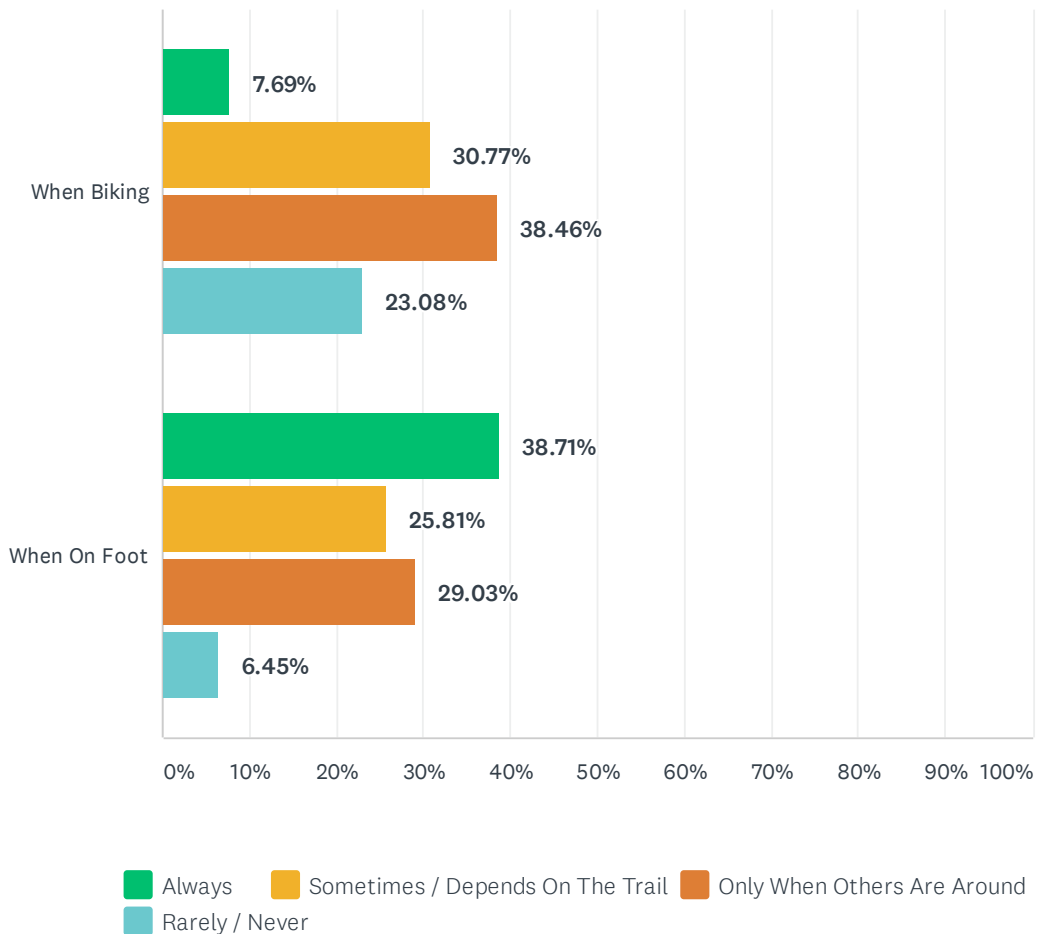
